From the Chairperson and Group CEO



It's our absolute pleasure to present the first Annual Report of PeopleKind Group.

PeopleKind Group is a for-purpose parent company to a range of human services organisations that make a positive and lasting difference in the Western Australia community.

While this is our inaugural annual report, our individual organisations have more than 130 years combined history of delivering services to some of the most vulnerable people in our community. These services are primarily funded by Commonwealth and State agencies and encompass disability services, child protection, allied health, housing, justice, reintegration, mental health, training and more.

On 5 September 2022, we officially launched PeopleKind Group as the new name of our parent company. This change from Nulsen Group was part of our ongoing strategic direction to diversify our offerings, build on existing work and identify new opportunities to ensure our future sustainability.

We've positioned PeopleKind Group to take advantage of the current policy and service environment while stretching our thinking on strategic growth and diversification. This has resulted in significant growth, reflected by a 36% increase in employees and a boost in revenue from \$74 million in 2021-22 to almost \$93 million this year.

In addition to growing and improving our services, we've focussed on building on the rich heritage and culture of our more established organisations, Nulsen Disability Services and Outcare.

At the same time, we've also been building culture and establishing market presence for our newer organisations – Liift Learning, Melior Positive Behaviour Support, Nesti Housing, Pillar Support Coordination and Superyou Therapy.

Of course, with growth comes opportunities and challenges. We commend our colleagues across all areas of the Group for their remarkable adaptability, resilience, and innovation in tackling the challenges that are inevitable with such large-scale change. Together, we've demonstrated the depth of our character and an unwavering commitment to our vision, purpose and values.

As we enter our second year as PeopleKind Group, we'll continue to enable the development of all our organisations through supporting governance, resourcing, and central functions.

Our commitment is to ensure that each organisation can thrive and flourish while supporting people to live their best life and reducing disadvantage in the Western Australian community.

Liift Learning

Liift is a Registered Training Organisation, recruitment and leadership management company. Liift provides formal qualifications and short courses under the accredited learning traineeship model to the greater business community in areas such as disability and community services, aged care, allied health, juvenile justice, and leadership.





Melior Positive Behaviour Support

Melior Positive Behaviour Support practitioners work with people to understand why they use behaviours of concern to get their needs met. With families, practitioners develop strategies for life, changing the social and physical environment to better meet a person's needs. The approach is evidence-based and places people at the centre of the work.





Nesti Housing

Nesti Housing is a Specialist Disability Accommodation (SDA) and community housing provider. Nesti also provides expert property management services.





Nulsen Disability Services

Nulsen provides 24/7 care, allied health services (Nulsen Therapy), and support services for people with complex disability, including those in NDIS supported independent living (SIL) homes. Nulsen's multidisciplinary approach ensures that a person with high care needs can enjoy a healthy, safe, and significant life.





Outcare

Outcare provides justice, reintegration and support services to help people engage positively with community. This includes Mental Health and support to people living in public housing through the Thrive Program.





Pillar Support Coordination

Pillar Support Coordination assist people with disability to get the most out of their NDIS plan. Pillar's highly experienced team empower people to navigate the NDIS and connect with the best services and supports for them.





Superyou Therapy

Superyou Therapy is an allied health organisation which delivers NDIS and private funded therapy services related to early child intervention; paediatric assessment & intervention for children 6+ years; functional capacity assessments & functional rehabilitation, driving assessment & rehabilitation; daily living capacity building; assistive technology assessment, prescription, and training; home modification, and more.






