From the Chairperson and Group CEO

As we reflect on the past year, we do so with deep gratitude and pride in the PeopleKind Group's resilience, growth, and unwavering commitment to our shared vision - A community where everyone belongs and feels connected.

2025 was a year of significant transition. We pay tribute to Gordon Trewern, whose 37 years of fearless leadership, advocacy and compassion have shaped our organisation's DNA. With Mark Fitzpatrick now leading as Group CEO, we are building on that legacy with renewed vision and energy. Mark brings deep experience in not-for-profit leadership, a strong commitment to community development, and a proven ability to forge meaningful partnerships across sectors. Under his guidance, we are beginning to see the rewards of the foundations laid in recent years, with a clear focus on sustainability, innovation and delivering impact for the people and communities we serve.

In 2025 Cahoots' transitioned into PeopleKind Group as a separate entity retaining its own brand, culture and executive leadership. Our Group navigated through a time of rapid changes, particularly with the ongoing reforms to the NDIS. These reforms brought challenges but also opened up new opportunities. Throughout the year, we've been strong advocates for fair pricing, sustainable services, and greater collaboration across the sector. Our subsidiaries have demonstrated incredible adaptability and creativity, ensuring that the thousands of people we support continue to receive the care and services they rely on.

From a financial perspective, the Group has remained steady and forward-looking. Despite pressures across the sector, we returned a surplus of \$4.6 million. This outcome reflects the Group's choice to keep investing in and supporting our diverse organisations. It also shows the benefits of a consistent focus on targeted investment, careful cost management, and building for long-term sustainability.

This year, we've also made some significant strides in the way we deliver services to people. Outcare became the first organisation in Western Australia to achieve accreditation under the new mental health standards - giving clients and their families extra confidence in the quality of care. Melior has expanded its children's services, reaching more young people who need support. Superyou's Voiceitt platform gained national recognition for innovation, opening new ways for people with

speech difficulties to communicate in their daily lives. Cahoots received a \$200,000 grant to enhance their Bayswater playground creating an even more welcoming and accessible space for the people they support. Nesti continued to strengthen its brand and reputation as a sector-defining organisation in housing, increasing its property management portfolio by 69% surpassing the 200 property milestone. Liift introduced their accredited and nationally recognized Mental Health First Aid course and at Nulsen, our registration and audit results set a benchmark, earning us a 'best practice' recognition and zero non-conformities - showing families and the community that they can trust the integrity of our services.

We are deeply grateful to our dedicated employees, partners, and supporters. Everything we achieve is made possible by their commitment and passion. They inspire us every day to keep striving for better outcomes for the people we support, their families, and the wider community.

Looking ahead, there is much to be optimistic about. While preparing for the next phase of NDIS reforms will remain a priority, we are also exploring new initiatives to strengthen our impact in Western Australia. By deepening partnerships and working together across our Group, we aim to play a leading and influential role in building a community where everyone belongs.

The challenges will continue, but so too will our determination to embrace innovation and set new standards of best practice.

The future for PeopleKind Group is full of promise - where belonging and connection enable people across Western Australia to live their best lives.

Cahoots

Cahoots run a variety of inclusive services and activities throughout the year, catering to people of all abilities aged 5+. Each of Cahoots' activities is run by a trained and experienced team to create inclusive opportunities for people living with disability and others that face exceptional challenges to develop friendships, skills and confidence.





Liift Learning

Liift Learning is a Registered Training Organisation (RTO 52989) that provides innovative accredited and non-accredited training programs tailored to the human services sector. Liift's programs can be flexible and adaptable, delivered with learner's needs and the industry at the forefront of their work.

Melior Positive Behaviour Support

Melior Positive Behaviour Support practitioners work with people to understand why they use behaviours of concern to get their needs met. With families, practitioners develop strategies for life, changing the social and physical environment to better meet a person's needs. The approach is evidence-based and places people at the centre of the work.









Nesti Housing

Nesti is bringing opportunity home to Western Australians, through a quality portfolio of housing solutions, including Specialist Disability Accommodation, community housing, and traditional real estate services. Backed by an experienced team of property managers, tenant coordinators, and repairs and maintenance officers.

Nulsen Disability Services

Nulsen provides 24/7 care, allied health services, and support services for people with complex disability, including those in NDIS supported independent living (SIL) homes. Nulsen's multidisciplinary approach ensures that a person with high care needs can enjoy a healthy, safe, and significant life.









Outcare

Outcare supports individuals facing challenges such as intergenerational trauma, mental health issues, family and domestic violence, and systemic barriers. While we have deep expertise in the justice and child protection systems, our work extends beyond those sectors to meet people where they are, when they need it most. Through our programs, we help build connected, resilient communities.



Superyou Therapy

Superyou Therapy is an allied health organisation which delivers NDIS and private funded therapy services related to early child intervention; paediatric assessment & intervention for children 6+ years; functional capacity assessments & functional rehabilitation, driving assessment & rehabilitation; daily living capacity building; assistive technology assessment, prescription, and training; home modification, and more.


